Religious Education Information-English and Spanish

- Please do not drop off students early. There is NO CHILDCARE before classes. The classrooms are open 10 minutes before class begins. Students must also be picked up promptly at the end of class. If there is an **emergency**, please call the RE Center during classes (882-4899)
- Parents must bring students into the classroom and pick up the students from the classroom or Church. Please do not leave your students in a classroom unless one of the Catechists is in the room. If someone other than a parent is picking up the students, please let the Catechist know. We will not release students to people we do not know! These are very important safety issues.
- We will meet with Parents in the Church at 6PM for our closing prayer service each week for Wednesday classes. Sunday classes will meet with Parents in the Church at noon to pray the Rosary before the 12:30PM Mass. Students will normally be dismissed to parents in the Church.
- The 'SNOW DAY' Policy is the same as city and county schools- if the schools declare a 'snow day' we will not have classes that same day. If it starts to snow late in the day and we must cancel for safety reasons, we will call and leave a message at the HOME phone number by 4PM.
- Youth Ministry (7-12 grade) sessions are listed on the attached calendar. Please make sure that a Catechist knows your Youth Ministry student is in the RE Center before you leave!
- Remember, YOU are your child's primary teacher in their Catholic Faith! What is taught in the RE Classes must be supported and reinforced at home!!

Sacramental Preparation for Children/Youth

First Reconciliation/First Communion for Children

Children who are in grades 2-6 will be registered in the Religious Education Program and will attend class on Wednesdays from 5-6:15PM or on Sundays in Spanish from 10:30AM-Noon. Sacramental Workshops for Reconciliation and First Communion are also required. See calendars. See Godparent/Sponsor requirements if your child will be accompanied by Godparent/Sponsor at First Communion Mass in English OR Spanish.

RCIA for Children

Children who are in grades 2-6 and are not yet **Baptized** will receive Baptism through the process of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults as adapted for Children. Children will be registered in the Religious Education Program and will attend class on Wednesdays from 5-6:15PM or Sundays in Spanish from 10:30AM-Noon. Sacramental Workshops for Baptism, Reconciliation and First Communion are also required. Children will be baptized on Easter Sunday. They will receive the Sacrament of First Communion on Sunday May 23, 2010. They must have a Baptismal Godparent. See Godparent/Sponsor requirements.

RCIA for Adolescents grades 7-12

Adolescents who are in grades 7-12 who have not yet been **Baptized or were Baptized in another Christian denomination or who have not yet received First Communion and Confirmation** will receive Sacraments (or make a Profession of Faith) through the process of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults as adapted for Youth. They will be required to attend the RCIA Youth sessions on Wednesdays from 5-6:15PM. Adolescents will receive the Sacraments of Baptism (or make a Profession of Faith), First Communion and Confirmation during the Easter Vigil Mass. They will be required to attend the Rite of Acceptance, Rite of Election, and the Scrutinies. See calendar for dates. Sacramental Workshops for Reconciliation and First Communion are also required. Students must have a Sponsor for Baptism/Confirmation. See Sponsor requirements.

Godparent/Sponsor Requirements:

The Godparent or Sponsor must be over the age of 16 and CANNOT be the Candidate's parent. They must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist and be a practicing Catholic in good standing with the Church- that is, attends Mass on a regular basis and receives Reconciliation and Eucharist at least once per year during the Easter Season as required by Church Law. If married, they MUST be in a valid Catholic marriage. *Proof of a valid marriage may be required.* Sponsors/Godparents who attend another Catholic Church other than Sacred Heart, Klamath Falls, must arrange to have a **Sponsor letter of eligibility** sent from their Catholic parish before Easter.
