**Ash Wednesday...**is on Wednesday February 17. **We will offer the following services on Ash Wednesday: Mass & Distribution of Ashes 8AM (English) & 7PM (bilingual). Prayer Service and Distribution of Ashes 12:15PM and 5:15PM (for Religious Education Children and their families).** All Catholics age 14 and older must abstain from all meat (beef, chicken, fowl, venison, etc.) on all Fridays of Lent and Ash Wednesday. All Catholics between the ages of 18-59 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. To 'fast' means to eat only one full meal; the other two meals that day should be less than the normal amount unless they are already at a minimum for good health. Eating between meals is not permitted; however, liquids are allowed.

**Consider Liturgy:** Liturgical commentators have some very good insights for us: Eamon Duffy writes: "The shift towards an emphasis on the primacy of human religious activity or experience, at the expense of the Latin Missal's relentless emphasis on the activity of God, is a striking feature of the 1973 version." (the present Missal) This is reiterated by John F. Baldovin: "If I were to argue only one point it would be that we need to understand that the liturgy is first and foremost God's act - a gift - and only secondarily something that we do." Through the Liturgy we receive the gift of God's own life. We are brought into the holy communion of the Blessed Trinity, we are divinized.
