Consider Liturgy: The Mass begins with Introductory Rites, moves to the Liturgy of the Word, the Preparation of the Gifts, the Liturgy of the Eucharist, the Communion and then the Dismissal. These elements have been an integral part of the Church's Liturgy from the early days of the Church. While we are familiar with these elements, each will be affected by the new translations.

The Gathering Rite ensures "that the faithful who come together as one establish communion and dispose themselves to listen properly to God's word and to celebrate the Eucharist worthily." (GIRM, 46) Thus, the full, active and conscious participation of the people is essential. No one can dispose them for participation. This is something they must do.
