Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Pastoral Corner...in 1997 I led a group of high school students to Paris, France for World Youth Days. It was quite an adventure- from a suddenly aborted flight take-off in Madrid, Spain, to a student breaking her ankle on a walking pilgrimage, from trying to discourage the kids from drinking alcohol at a Parisian disco (although it was legal) , to encouraging the students to try new foods (cold marinated squid with rice salad comes to mind) . We also had some amazing experiences that really deepened the faith of the students and adult chaperones- from a midnight candlelight prayer vigil with a large group of young Romanians, to celebrating Mass with Blessed Pope John Paul II, from praying at Notre Dame Cathedral to singing with Steve Angrisano and Tony Melendez. I was reminded of this trip when I reflected on the Gospel for today because, "Teacher, where are you staying? Come and see." was the theme for 1997 World Youth Days. The homily given by Blessed John Paul II at Mass that year focused on how the things of this world attract our reason and our will, but do not satisfy our spirit. The question, "Teacher where are you staying?" is born of our desire to seek God. Blessed John Paul II said that the Church responds every day that Christ is present in the Eucharist, in the sacrament of his death and resurrection. Have you asked Christ where he is staying? When Christ says in response, "Come and see." do you follow Him?
