


Father Steve will be at a Clergy Retreat this week.

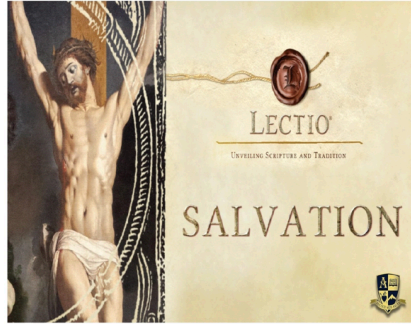
