If God is for us, who can be against us?

Romans 8:31

To the parishioners of Sacred Heart Parish,

It has been one year since my brother-in-law Robert died. His body was buried next to his sister Maria, who I was married to before I became a priest. Maria died of gastric cancer in 2010, a day before her birthday. In his younger years, Rob was quite an athlete. He toured around the country with a tree-planting crew. Rob suffered a lot later in his life. He had Ankylosing Spondylitis. It is a form of arthritis that is inherited genetically. It is more common among Native American males in the Pacific Northwest. When he started experiencing the effects of the disease, there was no effective treatment, so his body began to atrophy because of the tremendous pain he experienced in moving. At first, he tried to drink himself to death, but something happened in his soul, and he regained the will to live. He was involved in the test trials for Remicade. It was like a miracle drug for people in the early stages of the disease. Although it helped Rob, the disease had already exacted a huge toll on his body. He suffered multiple surgeries over 12 years, and his legs were amputated to above his knees. Surely, Rob had to get past the selfpity and the "this isn't fair" mentality. He eventually accepted life as it is. Often imperfect but worth living to a certain point. I cannot imagine how much pain he lived in for so long, yet he enjoyed his life to a certain point. "My God, my God, why have you abandoned me? Why so far from my call for help, from my cries of anguish? My God, I call by day, but you do not answer; by night, but I have no relief. Yet you are enthroned as the Holy One; you are the glory of Israel." (Ps 22: 2-4) Maria and I would visit Rob practically every weekend during those 12 years of surgeries. Maria never abandoned Rob. She was always there for him. "But Zion said, "The LORD has forsaken me; my Lord has forgotten me." Can a mother forget her infant, be without tenderness for the child of her womb? Even should she forget, I will never forget you." (Is 49: 14-15) The Incarnation of God shows us who we are. It shows us how God made us in His image. If God chose to take on our flesh and suffer and die with us, what do we have to fear? "If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son but handed him over for us all, how will he not also give us everything else along with him?" (Rom 8: 31b-32) Yes, Lord, you give us everything. Let us praise Him and give Him thanks for His love endures forever.






