I. Church Norms Concerning Godparents

It is the very ancient custom of the Church that at the celebration of the **sacrament of Baptism** or **Confirmation**, a godparent is present. The *function* of the godparent is:

- · Together with the celebrant who baptizes or confirms, to represent the Church in receiving the person into the communion of the Church.
- To support the person in living the Catholic Christian life.

In accord with Canon 874 of the Code of Canon Law, the Church can admit a person to the role of godparent if:

- He or she is more than sixteen years of age.
- Is a baptized Catholic who has been Confirmed, has already received the Blessed Eucharist, and lives a life of faith which befits the role to be undertaken.
- Is neither the father nor the mother of the person.

Note that the Catholic seeking to be admitted as a godparent "lives a life of faith which befits the role to be undertaken." This means that the candidate for godparent:

- Sincerely believes and strives to put into practice the Word of God as taught by the Catholic Church.
- · Prayerfully attends Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation.
